

Plan for REDCap sustainability

Goal: Improve REDCap support and data protection

The problem with unpaid projects:

- Unpaid projects have an increased risk of losing data due to a lack of administrative controls
- Unpaid projects aren't backed up
- Unpaid projects can only receive 1:1 help at the one hour weekly Digital Concierge and time is limited
- System has accumulated many unused projects with growing storage needs

The solution is to update the chargeback model to:


- Provide 1:1 support to all projects
- Improve data protection through administrative controls and backups
- Reduce unused projects

New REDCap Chargebacks (1)


- ► The new rate is \$100/year for all projects older than 90 days.
- ▶ All long-term projects (>90 days), regardless of their status (development, production, analysis, or completed/archived) are subject to the chargeback fee.
- ▶ With this change, you will benefit from scheduled 1:1 support and increased data protection when projects are moved to "production" mode.
- Paid projects will also be automatically backed up.
- ► Finance and Compliance approved this rate.
- ▶ If you intend to keep your project more than 90 days, you must provide a fund number, we will provide the link to do this on the REDCap page and our website.

New REDCap Chargebacks (2)

GREEN BANNER: PAID



YELLOW BANNER: FIRST 90 DAYS/UNPAID



New REDCap Chargebacks (3)

Projects < 90 days	54%
Projects > 90 days	46%

- ► Not all projects will need a fund number:
 - ▶ 54% of all projects are used for less than 90 days (for example, one-time or short-term surveys), so none of these projects will incur a chargeback fee
 - ▶ Student, hospital QI and operations projects will be paid directly by MSHS
- ► To provide you with sufficient time to account for the chargeback rate in your 2024 budget, payment for long-term projects is not due until January 31, 2024.
- ▶ Please contact us if you want to discuss special circumstances.

New REDCap Chargebacks (4)

- ► Unpaid projects will be deleted one year after the initial date of creation.
- ▶ All unpaid projects (older than 1 year) will be deleted on July 1, 2024.


Key Dates

- ► Starting on July 1, 2023
 - New REDCap projects have an initial, fee-free 90-day period
 - These new projects for 90 days, and PAID projects, will receive help through REDCap support tickets and can arrange 1:1 assistance
 - Rolling out banners so projects are marked as paid, or in first 90 days and unpaid
- ▶ Payment for 2023 is not due until January 31, 2024
- ▶ All unpaid projects (older than 1 year) will be deleted on July 1, 2024


